Dr Stephen Sherlock is a specialist in the politics and history of Southeast and South Asia and is currently focusing on political change, elections, political parties and parliamentary reform in Indonesia and East Timor. He holds a Masters degree and Doctorate in Asian History and Politics from the University of Sydney.

Dr Sherlock taught Asian Studies at the University of Western Sydney before moving to Canberra to take up a position as Foreign Affairs Adviser in the Australian Parliament. He worked for over a decade providing research and policy advice to Members of Parliament and parliamentary committees, with a special focus on Indonesia, East Timor, the Pacific and international development assistance. He lived in Indonesia for three years, working as a governance consultant for various international development institutions, including the World Bank. Now dividing his time between Indonesia and Australia, Dr Sherlock continues to provide consultancy services to multilateral and bilateral agencies on governance and political change in Indonesia and East Timor. He has published widely on issues such as trade unions and political movements in India and the politics of democratisation and institutional reform in Indonesia and East Timor.
